Mariposa Safe Routes to School Project

The scope of the Mariposa Safe Routes to School Project included the widening of approximately 2500 feet of roadway from Antelope Road to Lolita Avenue in the City of Citrus Heights, CA.

In addition to providing widening for improved vehicle and bicycle circulation, the project included new curbs, gutters and sidewalks for improved pedestrian safety and access for the students at Mariposa Avenue School and the construction of traffic calming improvements at the intersection of Watson Way and Antelope Road.

The Mariposa Avenue Project was a joint effort between the City of Citrus Heights and the San Juan Unified School District. The project also included parking lot, lighting, pedestrian walkway, bus shelter and circulation improvements at the Mariposa Avenue School. Paths of travel for pedestrians were designed to conform to Americans with Disability Act (ADA) compliance.

KASL Consulting Engineers performed land surveys and completed the site/civil design for all the improvements for the project. School improvement plans were reviewed and coordinated with the California Division of the State Architect.
